Midleton Barry Crockett:

Created to honour the legacy and efforts of previous master distillery Barry Crockett, Barry retired in 2013 after working at Midleton for 47 years. During his time, Barry helped create the Midleton we know and love today, also helping to create this single pot still whiskey, regarded as one of the best in the range and a stepping stone for greater thing within the Irish and wider whiskey community. A marriage of ex bourbon casks and virgin American oak, the bottling has no age statement but rest assured that the spirit within is around 25 years old. The whiskey is made using 3 levels of pot still, light medium and heavy.

Single pot still is an Irish method of distillation originally create to avoid paying taxes. Where-as single malt is 100% malted barley distilled at a single distillery, single pot still utilises both malted and unmalted barley mashed together and distilled at a single distillery, with historical tax being paid only on the amount of malted barley used in production. A happy side effect of the unmalted barley usage is a creamy, silky, softer mouther feel than that of the 100% malted barley, and tastes like sipping the smooth tones of Nina Simone. This was a sure favorite last year so we decided to bring it back!

Gelstons 26 Year Old:

This wonderful 26 year old single malt, bottled for the Gelston's range, was recently revived by the creator of Whitley Neill gins- Johnny Neill. The whiskey is named for Samuel Gelston who owned a wine and spirits company in Corporation Strett in Belfast in the 1830s, when he died the business was handed over to the Neill family. This whiskey is matured exclusively in ex-Bourbon casks and is bottled at Cask Strength.

Fercullen 18 year old:

An exquisitely Balanced Single Malt Irish Whiskey. Matured in bourbon barrels for over 18 years. Oak and Bourbon tones have married to deliver the perfect Whiskey for celebrating very special moments. Tasting notes reveal oak and bourbon tones which marry to give plenty of depth and character while retaining exquisitely balanced flavors: Nose: Honey, vanilla, sweet malty, spice, almonds, cinnamon, ripe fruits, rich cherries, plums and oak wood. Palate: Smooth. Layer upon layer of sweet, creamy malt, vanilla, ripe fruits, syrupy caramel, spice and crisp oak. Finish: Malty to start with a long-lasting sweet spice, malt and fruity finish.

Jameson 18 year old Cask Strength:

First launched in 2018, the Jameson Bow Street 18 Years Cask Strength Whiskey is joining the Midleton Very Rare in the distillery's limited yearly release range. Made from Single Pot Still Irish Whiskey and Single Grain Irish Whiskey aged for at least 18 years, from a mix of ex-Bourbon and ex-Sherry barrels, it's similar to the Jameson 18 year Limited Reserve, but with three key differences: No chill filtration, delivered at full cask strength and the location of the finishing.

EYE, Copper; NOSE, Caramel, sherry, coconut, Banana's Foster, Chocolate Twizzlers, roasted nuts, honey, oil, coconut and bits of dried fruit, leather and oak; PALATE, Caramel, herbal, honey, sherry, Strawberry Necco, spice, oak, citrus, honey, banana, cocoa, coconut and some graham and copper; FINISH, Long -> Oka, caramel, dried fruit, Strawberry Necco, spice, banana and ash; BALANCE, BODY & FEEL, Great balance, medium body and a slick oily feel.
